# RULES & REGULATIONS



Participants will work perpetually over 24 hours on innovative projects across the following domains:

- Open track
- Web 3.0 & Blockchain
- Generative AI & Machine Learning
- Web-App

## 1. Participation Requirements

- Eligibility: Open to students currently enrolled in accredited educational institutions.
- Team Size: Teams must consist of 3 to 4 members.
- Registration: All team members must complete registration through the official registration links only. Late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances. Registration fee ₹300 per head.

## 2. Idea Submission

- Teams are required to submit their project ideas by the specified deadline. Projects must align with one of the hackathon's domains.
- Ensure that you follow the guidelines provided by the application used for conducting the hackathon.
- Evaluation Criteria: Projects will be judged based on creativity, technical feasibility, impact in the society and presentation.

## 3. Hackathon Structure

- An inauguration ceremony will take place before the commencement of the hackathon.
- Upon conclusion of the 24 hours, teams are required to present their working model, wherein each team will be allotted 10 minutes for their presentation.
- Teams can work continuously on-site throughout the event, with access to mentors, industry experts, and necessary resources.







#### 4. Code of Conduct

- Participants are advised to bring essential items, including bedsheets, pillows, and any personal medications.
- Strict action will be taken for misconduct, including drug use, sexual harassment, vulgarity, intimidation, inappropriate disruption, or discrimination
- Derogatory language, threats, or intimidation will not be tolerated.
- Recording without consent is prohibited (e.g., photographing, video, or audio recording of presentations without the presenter's permission).
- Participants must respect copyrights—no plagiarism or reuse of past work will be allowed.
- Any violation of these rules may result in immediate disqualification and expulsion from the hackathon.
- Respect and Professionalism: Participants are expected to respect all attendees and accept constructive feedback gracefully.
- Participants should report any violations of the rules to event organizers or staff immediately. Zero tolerance is maintained for misconduct, and all reports will be handled confidentially and with utmost seriousness. Designated organizing team members will be available throughout the event to ensure a safe and respectful environment.

#### 5. Resources

- Participants will have access to internet resources at the venue.
- Participants will be provided with OpenAI API to use during the hackathon.
- Personal equipment, including laptops, chargers, extension cords, power banks, and any additional tools or devices necessary for project development, must be brought by participants.
- Participants are responsible for safeguarding their belongings throughout the event, as the organizers will not be liable for any lost or damaged items.







## 6. Prizes

- The total prize pool is ₹40,000 and +\$500 partner prize pool. Check the hackathon website and its Devfolio page for more details and the [code of conduct](#).
- Additional perks include networking opportunities with industry professionals.

## 7. Mentorship and Workshops

- Throughout the event, mentors will be available to guide in the respective domains.
- Participants are highly encouraged to network and connect with fellow attendees, mentors, and industry experts throughout the event. This is a valuable opportunity to build professional relationships and expand your knowledge and skills.

## 8. Judging and Awards

- Judging Criteria: Projects will be evaluated based on innovation, technical complexity, usability, scalability, presentation and its impact in the society
- Teams must present their final projects to a panel of judges for evaluation.
- The determination of winners will be based on overall excellence, transcending the specific domains of the projects.

## 9. Miscellaneous

- Food and refreshments will be provided at the venue.
- Participants are kindly requested to make their own travel arrangements, as transportation will not be provided, and any associated expenses will not be reimbursed.
